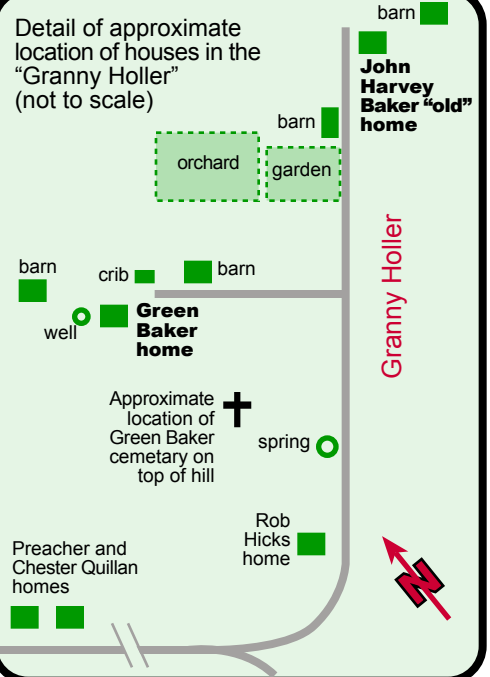


Highway 229 is about 1200 yards over this ridge.
